

PLANS FUNDED STATUS


This year the actuarial valuation again reported improved funded ratios for the Nebraska School and Patrol plans, while the Nebraska Judges plan experienced a decrease. As of July 1, 2020, the Judges plan funding decreased from 98.08% to 97.34%. The School plan increased from 90.65% to 91.65% and the State Patrol plan increased from 87.34% to 88.13%. We can proudly say the Nebraska Defined Benefit plans remain on strong financial footing despite the recent economic tremors.

.52% COLA INCREASE FOR 2020

Effective July 1, 2020, eligible School, Judges, and Patrol retirees received a cost of living adjustment (COLA) in their monthly benefit distributions. The COLA is calculated using the consumer price index and may be capped at 2.5% or 1.0% per plan provisions. For the year ending June 30, 2020, the CPI increase was .52%. As a result, all School, Judges and State Patrol retirees received a .52% increase.

NPERS issued correspondence to all affected retirees at the end of July. If you were eligible for the COLA increase, this letter explained the type of COLA and actual dollar amount of your increase. If you have questions about the COLA, please refer to your plan handbook or contact NPERS.

WATCH YOUR MAIL FOR FORM 1099-R



NPERS will mail your IRS Form 1099-R tax statement by the end of January 2021. Please remember to keep your mailing address updated with NPERS in order to receive your 1099-R in a timely fashion and ensure uninterrupted benefit payments. Individuals who need to update their address may use the address change form on the back of this newsletter.

The information on Form 1099-R should be used to file your 2020 federal and state tax returns. Your 1099-R will show the gross benefits you received from NPERS in 2020. This form will also indicate the federal and, if applicable, Nebraska income taxes withheld from your benefit payments and, for most people, the taxable portion of your benefit. A copy of the 1099-R is also available to retirees who have created an NPERS online account.

Please direct questions about individual tax liability to your accountant, tax professional, the Internal Revenue Service, or your state Department of Revenue.

ANNUITY TAX WITHHOLDING REMINDER

Each year NPERS is required to notify retirees of your right to change, start, or stop federal tax withholding from your monthly retirement benefit. If you wish to adjust your withholding, you may submit these changes via the NPERS online account access or by filing a new Withholding Certificate for Annuity Payments form. This form may be obtained from the "Forms" section of the NPERS website at npers.ne.gov or by calling our office.

You are not required to have federal income tax withheld from your monthly benefit; however, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) may assess interest or penalty charges if your estimated tax payments or withholding amounts fall short of your tax liability.

If you are a Nebraska resident and you choose to have federal income tax withheld from your benefits, NPERS is required to withhold Nebraska taxes using the allowances and marital status you claimed for federal withholding. You may elect additional amounts of withholding for both your federal and/or state withholding; these amounts are not required to match. If you choose not to have federal tax withheld from your retirement benefit payment, you are not required to have Nebraska state income tax withheld. If you are not a Nebraska resident, NPERS is not required to withhold Nebraska taxes from your benefit payment.

No action is necessary if your present tax authorization for your monthly retirement benefit still fits your needs. Questions regarding how much to withhold should be directed to a tax professional.

CHANGE YOUR TAX WITHHOLDING ONLINE

There are two separate and distinct options for online account access, NPERS and Ameritas. Retirees who have created an NPERS account can change the taxes withheld on their pension/annuity payments.
